
Thank you to all those who have helped make this the largest cattle show in ND; we appreciate your continued support and welcome you to join us again! We are excited about a few changes for this year's event!

MEET THE 2017 JUDGES

Guy Laflin, of St. Ignatius, MT, will be judging the Open Show in Main Arena 2, the "Fairest of Them All" Show, and also helping in the Pen Show. He takes none of it for granted and knows all this is possible today because of hard work, determination, family unity, and a dream that is more than 100 years old. For five generations, the Laflin family has known the ranching way of life and passed down the values and respect for the land and livestock that go with it. Guy's great-grandfather, E.B., established the Laflin Angus herd in 1900, and was one of the first breeders in the state of Nebraska. Today, the herd spreads out on the Flint Hills of Kansas and is now the second oldest registered Angus herd in the United States. Guy has done a great deal of judging in numerous states and at a National level. In addition, he has shown animals in the United States, Canada, and Argentina. Guy is looking forward to working with staff and participants at this year's North Star Classic.

Jim Bloomberg, of Berwick, IL, will be judging the "Fairest of Them All" Show, Showmanship, and the Junior Show, in Main Arena 1. Jim has been married to his wife, Mary, for 32 years. Together they have three children, Blake, Jamie, and Jake, whom are all involved in exhibiting numerous breeds during their junior years and now are judging across the country as well. The Bloomberg family is primarily involved with raising Simmental breeding stock but also raise Herefords, Angus, and Charolais. Jim has been fortunate to have evaluated local, regional, and national shows including Denver, Kansas City, Louisville, and Houston.

Dr. Blake Bloomberg is an Assistant Professor of Applied Animal Science at Oklahoma State University. Blake and his wife, Wravenna, were married in 2009 and welcomed a daughter, Breckyn, in July 2012, and twin boys, Brenhem and Berwick, in March 2014. Blake was raised in Berwick, IL on his family's diversified livestock operation that consisted of cattle, hogs and row crops. Dr. Bloomberg currently serves as the Livestock Judging Coach at Oklahoma State University. During his career, Blake has coached the Reserve National Champion Livestock Judging Teams in 2009, 2014 and 2015. Blake was named the 2008, 2009 and 2014 National Collegiate Coaches Association Coach of the Year. He also serves as co-coach of their Meat Animal Evaluation Team with Dr. Gretchen Mafi that were the Reserve National Champion in 2010, 2016 and 2017 and National Champion in 2011, 2014 and 2015. Blake attended Black Hawk East Jr. College and was a member of the 2004-2005 judging team that was defeated only once. He was the High Point Individual at the 2006 National Intercollegiate Livestock Judging Contest and was also a member of the 2006 National Champion

Livestock Judging Team for Texas A&M that was undefeated in competition. Blake has judged livestock shows in 42 states and 3 foreign countries including events at the American Royal, North American International Livestock Exposition, National Western Stock Show, Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, San Antonio Livestock Show, and several regional and state events.

Hampton Cornelius is the 2nd generation cattleman and family partner from Coyote Ridge Ranch - a purebred Hereford cattle ranch in Colorado. As a youth he was active in Jr Hereford, 4-H & FFA with livestock projects and an integral part of the family ranch. He attended Northeastern Junior College and Colorado State University and was on the livestock judging teams at both schools. He won many accolades for livestock judging including the at both of these schools and was the recipient of the Tom Blackburn Award for Outstanding Member of the Livestock Judging Team.

Hampton has judged numerous national cattle shows as well as internationally. These include the 2013 National Hereford Show at the National Western Stock Show in Denver Colorado, the 2015 Expo Prado National show in Uruguay, 2017 National Hereford Show at the NAILE in Louisville KY and the 2017 ROV Angus Show at the Fort Worth Stock Show.

Since joining the family Hereford ranch in 1993, he has focused on developing Herefords suitable for commercial bull customers in the Rocky Mountain West. His focus on "balancing" highly productive, fertile cows with maintaining phenotype and carcass qualities has been the hallmark of the CRR breeding program. His most gratifying work has been raising cattle that have gone on to be breed leaders both in the United States and also used internationally – such as CRR About Time 743, CRR Violet and CRR Catapult 109.

Hampton's cattle have been shown to Grand Champion honors at all the major Hereford shows in the United States – including the National Western Stock Show, American Royal, Hereford Junior National Expo, the Western National in Reno NV, and the Fort Worth Stock Show. Most recently his bull calves, sired by CRR Catapult, back-to-back won the prestigious Hereford Bull Pen Show at the NWSS in Denver CO in January 2016 & 2015 and the Reserve Grand Champion Hereford Bull at the Fort Worth Stock Show in Texas in February 2015.

Hampton is married to Kay Cornelius and they have a 16-yearold son – John Hampton Cornelius. Together with his mother Jane Evans Cornelius they are all partners on their family's cattle ranch – Coyote Ridge Ranch - in Eastern Colorado.

2017 NSC JUNIOR EVENTS

Once again, there will be a number of activities for juniors at the North Star Classic! Saturday's events will begin with a NDSU Judging Clinic at 8 am in the main arena, followed by a Fitting Clinic by H&H Show Supply at 10 am. Again this year, we are hoping to hold a Nutritional Clinic which will follow the fitting clinic, at 11 am, and at Noon, the "Fairest of Them All" Show is scheduled. This show will feature overall grand champion heifers from any fair, achievement days, or ND Junior Point Show in ND, in 2017, all competing for the chance to win the "Fairest of Them All" title and a \$750 prize! More information on this show can be found online, at www.northdakotawintershow. com. The cattle sales will then be in the afternoon and



evening on Saturday and showmanship will once again be that night, at 7 pm.

On Sunday, the Junior Breed Shows, the Overall Supreme Heifer Show and the Ag Country Junior Market Steer and Heifer Showdown are all scheduled, with the breed shows beginning at 8 am. This year we welcome judges, Jim Bloomberg, from Berwick, IL and Blake Bloomberg, from Stillwater, OK, to judge the Junior Shows.

Great prizes will be awarded to exhibitors of the champion heifers, in each breed class, as well as to the showmanship champions in each age division. Thank you to Ray Haugen, of Silver Creek Ranch, for once again sponsoring a portion of these prizes! All Grand Champion Heifers will advance to the Overall Junior Supreme Heifer Show, where both a Grand and Reserve Heifer will be chosen, with special thanks going to John Deere Seeding Group, for sponsoring these champion heifer premiums.

The Ag Country Junior Market Steer & Heifer Showdown is again the last event on Sunday. This show will have pay-outs given to the top four winners in each class, as well as to the top four market animals overall.







2017 LIVESTOCK HONOREE



Cal Schaefer, of Valley City, ND, is this year's livestock honoree. He is a fourth generation Barnes County resident living Northwest of Valley City about 20 miles on a farm purchased by his great grandfather around 1904, which they named as "The Schaefer Hill". Cal has lived in the same house his whole life, and continues to do so while working the family business on the farm. He has been involved with livestock since day one, along with farming and helping his family.

He attended Stewart School, which was a small schoolhouse, up until the 8th grade; then went on to attend Valley City High School and graduated in 1960. At the age of 21, he then started working for the North Dakota Winter Show in 1963, as part of the barn crew. He would work wherever his help was needed, from cleaning to setting up for rodeos and stage shows. He worked there for 10 years until he started his own booth during the big agricultural show held in March for Vermeer in 1973. He has sat there every year since as a vendor selling Vermeer balers, mowers, wrappers, and hay rakes. Just recently Cal was honored by the North Dakota Winter Show Board for being one of the longest-tenured vendors at the show. He first became a dealer for the Vermeer baler business in August of

1972. During this time he served for the National Guard from 1964 – 1970. One time that really stands out in his life is the blizzard of '66, he was working at the barn when it started, it was only supposed to be around 5 inches of snow; until it kept going and the wind was blowing so hard, you couldn't even walk against it. There were cattle in the barn as the Winter Show was supposed to start the next day; but was postponed a week later due to the blizzard. Cal was stuck at the barn and "lived" there for that week; all while getting whatever food he could find in the café and sleeping on the couch in the lounge. There were 40 foot drifts in some areas which meant no one could get to him and he couldn't get out, leaving his family on the farm to take care of the cows without his help.

In 1967, while cruising in his red dodge convertible down Broadway in Fargo, he met a girl, "Gerri" and a year later, they were married. Together they have two children Kyle and Kaneia, and 4 grandchildren, Austin, Eric, Tessa, and Deanna. Kyle, Austin, and Eric help Cal out as much as they can with the family-owned business, from selling equipment to booth duties. Some of Cal's many hobbies include hunting, fishing, spearfishing in the winter, and dancing. He loves to dance so much, he has already taken his wife out dancing about 100 different times this year alone! He spearfishes on any lake he can see through, with an opening of 34 – 44 inches around, big enough to throw the spear in. He recalls one year, he had his icehouse sitting from December to March and he had caught around 325 Northerns with his spear! He also started a collection of his own around 1980, when him and his family were walking along the railroad and found a date nail, or railroad ties that are dated, by the Crossing. One led to more and eventually he had a variety of date nails in which he put together by year and branded companies. The oldest year he has is from 1899. Another event he really enjoyed was when he drove 18 laps at the Las Vegas Speedway in the Nascar #24 reaching nearly 130 mph. Driving the car that fast reminded him of when he drove his Lamborghini at 128 mph! He also got to ride along with one of the Nascar drivers with them reaching speeds up to 165mph! Schaefer's family farm has donated hay and straw to the Winter Show for all of their events the last few years and continues to do so. Cal enjoys coming year after year promoting his hometown!

LIABILITY: Each animal will be the buyer's risk as soon as sold and settlement must be made at the completion of the sale. All persons attending these sales do so at their own risk. The Breed Associations, sales managers, directors, clerk, and North Star Classic management assume no liability, legal or otherwise, for their safety or the behavior of the animals.

HEALTH: All livestock will be accompanied by proper health certificates for immediate shipment.

REGISTRATION AND TRANSFER: All purebred livestock sell with registration certificate and will be transferred to new owner in accordance with the respective national breed associations.

BREEDER' GUARANTEE: All animals sold are guaranteed breeders by the owner. Females in calf are considered breeders without further guarantee. All females sold are guaranteed to be breeders. Each owner accepts the responsibility of guarantee of his own animals and has the privilege of giving additional guarantee on his livestock at the time of their sale in the auction ring. All complaints regarding breeding difficulties must be reported in writing by the buyer within the time limit of the respective breed association and any animal returned must be free from disease and in good condition.
