 Heifers may be nominated and entered. All rules and judging criteria will be the same as listed for steers. Classes will not be separated by sex.

Rules & Regulations:

- 1. All steers must have been born between January 1st and April 30th, 2017.
- 2. Steers must be weighed between the dates of October 18th and October 25th, 2017. The date weighed and the actual weight of the steer shall be recorded and witnessed on the nomination form.
- 3. Steers must be permanently identified at the time of nomination with a <u>legible tattoo.</u> The tattoo must be readable at the time of the first weigh-in on Saturday, March 3rd, 2018.
- 4. Two disinterested parties, other than the owner(s) or their families; must witness the weighing and date weighed of the nominated steer; and sign the nomination form to that effect.
- 5. The nomination form must be entirely completed.
- 6. All steer entries are to be nominated on the official nomination form and the form returned to the North Dakota Winter Show, postmarked no later than November 6th, 2017.
- 7. A \$10 non-refundable nomination fee, per steer, must accompany the nomination form. The nomination fee will be used for part of the premium payment.
- 8. The individual exhibitors may nominate and show up to 10 steers, unless otherwise limited by the show committee (see rule #16).
- 9. All steers must have a minimum 3.0 lbs. WDA (weight per day of age) at time of nomination.
- 10. Final registration will be made or postmarked no later than February 19th, 2018. An additional \$45 non-refundable registration fee, plus a \$10 bedding fee, must accompany each steer.

(No substitutions will be allowed)

11. Steers must weigh a minimum of 1000 pounds at the preliminary weigh-in on Saturday, March 3rd, 2018, to be eligible to show. A second weigh-in will be on Sunday, March 4th. The average of these two weights will be the official weight. The dressing percentage will be indexed and utilized in the final calculation of WDA and ADG figures.

- 12. Any artificial means of removing or remedying the physical defects or conformation in exhibition cattle, such as cutting ties or lifting and filling under the skin, surgical removing of excess brisket or dewlap skin, etc., will be considered as deception and fraud. All animals giving evidence of such treatment will be barred from competition at the North Dakota Winter Show and the owner will forfeit all awards. All animals shall conform to the ND Beef Quality Assurance guidelines.
- 13. Steers will not show evidence of or remnants of testicles.
- 14. Steers may be mouthed and tattoos will be read when weighed. Steers must have all eight temporary incisors firmly in place. There may be no evidence of eruption of any permanent incisors. Such animals are considered as having reached an age beyond that consistent with the intent and purpose of this show and will be barred from competition at the North Dakota Winter Show.
- 15. Any animal misrepresented in the information requested on the nomination form will be barred from competition at the North Dakota Winter Show and the owner will forfeit all awards.
- 16. Because of limited slaughter facilities, in the event more than 30 steers are eligible for slaughter, "exhibitors" (per family) with more than one steer entered will be required to drop one or more steers from the show. The entry fee will be refunded for these steers. To allow you the most flexibility, we will allow you to bring all the steers you have entered to the show. Following the initial weigh-in on Saturday, the exhibitor will choose the steer(s) that will be excluded from the show. Only steers in the show will be sold at the auction. In the event other exhibitors cancel from the show and fewer than 30 steers meet the minimum weight requirement, a lottery will determine which extra steers will be added to bring the total number in the show to 30. The drawing will be held following the initial weigh-in. As in the past, exhibitors are responsible for steers that are not in the show.
- 17. Ten (10) percent of the premium monies will be deducted from your check for expenses related to the Classic Steer Show and Auction.
- 18. Stall cards will be provided and must be utilized. The steers will be displayed together in a special display area and must remain in the barn for the duration of the show.
- 19. All livestock must be stalled and weighed, at the times listed on the show schedule, to participate.
- 20. <u>Federal Regulation:</u> Performance steers will be observed and may be tested for "violative residue levels". Steers will be observed for symptoms or injection lesions and residue tests will be conducted.

Brand Inspections: All steers in the Classic Steer Show shall be brand inspected by an official brand inspector of the North Dakota Stockmen's Association at weigh-in on Saturday, March 3rd.

<u>Premiums:</u> Payment to top steers in overall competition will be on a floating scale based on a composite score of: weight per day of age at nomination-25%; average daily gain-25%; live placing-10%; and value of retail cuts per day of age-40%. The overall scale is as follows:
