## OFFICIAL RULES FOR COOKS NDWS CHILI COOK-OFF Tuesday, March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025, 4:00P.M. - 8:00P.M. Doors Open @ 5:30 PM

## THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE TO BE ADHERED TO BY ALL CHILI COOK-OFF TEAMS:

- 1. Entrants must fill out a registration form and return it to North Dakota Winter Show by 5:00pm, Friday, February 28, 2025, 700 7<sup>th</sup> St. SE, Valley City, ND 58072, or e-mail <u>ndws@northdakotawintershow.com</u>
- 2. NO alcohol/liquor will be allowed at the event.
- 3. Chili must be prepared and pre-cooked in a health safe environment. Fire regulations prohibit propane or natural gas in facility.
- 4. The NDWS will provide each team with the following:
  - a. 10' x 10' booth
  - b. table
  - c. electrical outlet
- 5. Each team is responsible for providing the following:
  - a. A minimum of 2 roasters of chili.
  - b. Cooking and serving provisions (must accommodate 110 volts ac).
  - c. Electrical extension cord (depending on your booth location, the outlets are sometimes multiple feet away so plan accordingly).
  - d. Plastic gloves, washing facilities and towels.
  - e. Sign with the Chili Cook-off team name they are using.
  - f. All display/promotional material/designs must be within the 10' x 10' booth.
- 6. Schedule
  - a. The west doors will open promptly at 4:00 p.m. to let vehicles in for setup. All vehicles must leave the arena at 4:45 p.m. All vehicles must enter and exit at the same time due to a new heating system in the building. Teams must be ready to serve for judging at 5:00 p.m.
  - b. Judging at 5:00 p.m. Be sure that all participants are present for group photo.
  - c. Cup sales to public beginning at 5:30 p.m.
- 7. Support team members may not exceed 12 people.
- 8. Demonstration of team spirit throughout the spectator area is encouraged. However, teams are asked to respect the visitors.
- 9. All contestants who have special requirements are asked to notify the NDWS at least three days in advance of the event.
- 10. All vehicles must be removed from the arena at 5:00 p.m.
- 11. Upon completion of chili tasting and trophy awards, all competitors must tear down their booth and remove all items from the arena.
- 12. Prizes will be awarded in the following categories:

1<sup>st</sup> Place 2<sup>nd</sup> Place People's Choice Best Decorated Booth

13. The decision of the judges shall be final.
