

MEET THE 2021 JUDGES

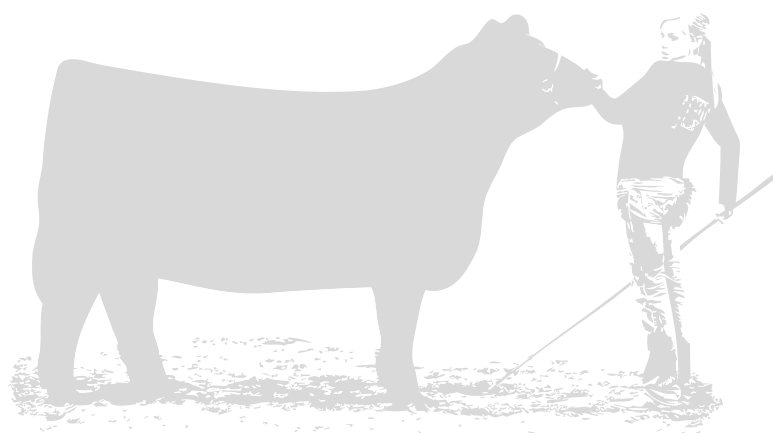
Patrick Wall is co-owner and operator of PAW Livestock, LLC, a purebred hereford operation located near Pleasantville, Iowa. With his wife Amanda, daughter Addison and son Brody, they focus on genetics that can thrive in a fescue environment, yet can compete on a national level. Wall also owns a genetic consulting firm and works full-time for Iowa State University as a Beef Extension Specialist. He's a graduate of Black Hawk East, holds a B.S. and M.S. from Iowa State, and was named to the All-American Livestock Judging Team in 2001. Patrick will be joining us this year for our Open and Pen Show!

Brent Stagemeyer of Page, NE, will be joining us to judge the Open Show on Friday and the Pen Show on Saturday. Brent, along with his wife Carla and three sons Miles, Jace, and Tucker, run a diversified operation of row crops, custom backgrounding, and cow/calf operation. Stagemeyer Cattle Company offers a handful of heifers for sale every year online, from their select donor herd. The Stagemeyers have had success in the showing by exhibiting the Supreme heifer at the American Royal, Champion heifer at Kansas City, and multiple other champions at the county and state level. Brent states that the family enjoys the show industry and the family time that it brings them!

John Nelson is from Chickasha, Oklahoma where his family runs a purebred seedstock operation of Red Angus Cattle. John grew up showing all species of livestock and has campaigned several national champions in both cattle and sheep. John attended junior college at Connors State, then continued his education at Oklahoma State University. He was named a member of the 2018 National Champion Senior College Livestock Judging Team which was later named the most successful team in Oklahoma State University's history. John was also a member of the 2018 Reserve National Champion Meat Animal Evaluation Team. John has since graduated Oklahoma State University magna cum laude and is now in his second year at UND Law. John will be judging our "Fairest of Them All" Show!

Scott Bayer is from Ringle, WI where he owns and operated TC Reds and Country Lane Farm with his family. Scott and his family hold several production sales throughout the year, selling breeding stock nationwide. He and his family have successfully raised and shown champions on many levels – including having both Red Angus and Angus champions in Louisville, Denver, multiple State Fairs and at the National Jr. Red Angus show. Over the years, Scott has been honored to have judged at many shows- including the National Western Stock Show, American Royal, North American Livestock Exposition, multiple State Fairs and regional shows. Scott will be judging our showmanship competition and junior shows at the 2021 North Star Classic.

Ty Bayer will be judging the Showmanship & Junior Shows at the 22nd Annual North Star Classic. Ty attended Junior College at Lincoln Land Community College in Springfield, IL, where he was an active member of the livestock judging team. Heifer calves purchased in the Hereford Sale are eligible to compete in a futurity comeback show at the Junior Hereford Field Day or the Great Plains Junior Hereford Show held during the Red River Valley Fair in West Fargo, ND.

Each consignor will contribute \$20 per heifer consigned in this sale along with each junior who intends to compete in either of these two shows. The money will be split and paid out according to how many show in either of these two shows. Also, the association has agreed to pay all juniors \$20 per head at these two shows when leaving the ring.

The NDHA sponsors Hereford steer premiums each year at the ND Junior Hereford Field Day and at the Great Plains Regional Junior Hereford Show in July during the Red River Valley Fair in West Fargo, ND.

The NDHA will pay \$200 for champion and \$100 for reserve champion steers for the NDJHA filed day event. They must be from a registered sire and dam with the AHA.

There is also a junior show featuring a Hereford steer show during the Midwest Classic Jr. Hereford Show in Pipestone, MN. This show will be held June 18-19, 2022.
