Scholarship Guidelines

IMPORTANT: Please read all guidelines before completing this application. All applications MUST be typed. Application forms are in PDF format. Complete application and SAVE to your computer. You must print off the application. Applications <u>must</u> include the application form; high school verification form; references; and your narrative. **ALL APPLICATIONS AND HIGH SCHOOL VERIFICATION FORMS MUST BE SIGNED.**

Who is Eligible: To be eligible to apply for a scholarship applicant must be a resident of North Dakota; meet criteria of academic standing; have enrollment plans at a college or university in North Dakota; and demonstrate leadership, character, and citizenship.

Application Deadline: The deadline for submitting applications is **February 15** of this year. Applications will be accepted if postmarked on or before that date. Applications must be mailed to the address shown above, or hand delivered to the North Dakota Winter Show office, by the application deadline.

Scholarship Amounts: The amount of the scholarship is currently \$500. Up to two (2) scholarships are available.

Requirements/Criteria: The following requirements/criteria apply to all applications.

Citizenship: The applicant must be a citizen of the United States or be born in the United States and be a resident of the State of North Dakota.

Residency: The applicant must be a graduating senior or have been a qualified mid-term graduate of an accredited North Dakota High School.

Academic Standing: The applicant must be a graduating senior ranked in the upper one-half (½) of his/her graduating class at the completion of his/her first semester of the senior year or at the time of applicant's mid-term graduation.

College/University Acceptance/Enrollment: The applicant must enroll, or plan to enroll, in either a college or university in the State of North Dakota with preference given to applicants who pursue a curriculum leading to a degree in an agricultural related career.

Activities: Leadership potential and character of the applicant should be demonstrated through an applicant's response to the categories of the application detailing school, extra-curricular and community activities and achievements. Participation in agricultural experiences, such as 4-H projects, SAE (Supervised Agricultural Experience), or other individual experiences help determine responsibility, character, and commitment to agriculture.

Narrative: Each applicant must include a typed narrative of no more than two (2) 8½ x 11 pages, double-spaced, 12 point font. The narrative is <u>extremely</u> important as it takes the place of a personal interview. It should address why a career in agriculture is important to the applicant. In the narrative, the applicant should also present any information he/she feels the evaluation should pay any particular attention to. **Applicant's name, address, and high school <u>must</u> appear as a heading to the narrative in the upper right hand corner of page one.**

References: Each application must submit two (2) letters of personal reference from persons other than the high school official who certifies the application. Suitable references would include 4-H leaders, extension personnel, FFA advisors, employers, teachers, or others who are familiar with the applicant's work ethic, skills, attitude, and commitment to agriculture.

Photo: Please submit a wallet-size photo with application which may be used for publicity purposes.
